Chemical Control of Phytophthora Root Rot of Newly Planted Avocados in Western Australia.

Abstract

Root rot, caused by P. cinnamomi, was less in trees treated with granular metalaxyl than in those treated with sprays of fosetyl aluminium. Poultry manure, hay and lime did not protect trees from infection. After 8 months the pathogen could not be detected in roots sampled from trees receiving metalaxyl.
